

MARKET OVERVIEW


Morgantown is a city in and the county seat of Monongalia County, West Virginia. Situated along the banks of the Monongahela River, Morgantown is the largest city in North-Central West Virginia, and the base of the Morgantown, West Virginia MSA. Morgantown, located just south of the Mason-Dixon line with a population of 31,073, is best known as the home of West Virginia University and the one-of-a-kind Morgantown Personal Rapid Transit system. The presence of West Virginia University, an extensive health care network and the continued growth of advanced technology industries along the "I-79 High Tech Corridor," help to ensure a bright and prosperous future for the Morgantown MSA.

With the most dynamic and active economy in West Virginia, Morgantown is growing in many ways including the housing, manufacturing, research and commercial sectors. Morgantown shows continued population growth for the last 20 years, and is located in one of the fastest growing counties in the State. Morgantown have consistently seen some of the lowest unemployment rates in the state, supported by major employers in the area include the National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH), Mylan Pharmaceuticals, West Virginia University and FedEx Ground.

Morgantown's economy is stabilized and driven primarily by the large West Virginia University with a current MSA population of over 130,000 people. Within a 500 mile radius of Morgantown is one-half of the population of the United States and one-third of the population of Canada. Morgantown is one day's drive from 6 of the 8 largest U.S.

metropolitan areas, 20 metro areas with populations of 1 million or more, and 22 of the nation's top 35 industrial markets.

Morgantown's future and prosperity has been noted in articles in BusinessWeek. Forbes, Fortune, Southern Living and Kiplinger magazines and the attitude is quite probusiness. The community is also consistently rated as one of the best small metropolitan areas in the country for both business climate and quality of life. Recent rankings include: Kiplinger.com included Morgantown in their 10 great places to live list; one of "Best Sports Cities" by Sporting News; 5th "Best Small Metro" by Forbes; 12th overall "Hottest Small City" by Inc.; One of "50 Smartest Places to Live" by Kiplinger's; and the second-ranking "Best College Town for Jobs" by Forbes.





WEST VIRGINIA UNIVERSITY OVERVIEW

West Virginia University (WVU) is a public, land-grant, space-grant, research-intensive university in Morgantown, West Virginia, United States. Its other campuses include the West Virginia University Institute of Technology in Montgomery and Potomac State College of West Virginia University in Keyser; and a second clinical campus for the University's medical and dental schools at Charleston Area Medical Center in Charleston. WVU Extension Service provides outreach with offices in all of West Virginia's 55 counties.

The Morgantown campus comprises three sub-campuses. The original main campus, typically called the Downtown Campus, is in the Monongahela River valley on the fringes of Morgantown. This part of campus includes eight academic buildings on the National Register of Historic Places. The Downtown Campus comprises several architectural styles predominantly featuring red brick including Victorian

Second Empire, Federal, Neoclassical, and Collegiate Gothic among others. The Evansdale Campus, a mile and a half north-northwest, on a rise above the flood plain of the Monongahela River, was developed in the 1950s and 1960s to accommodate a growing student population, since space for expansion was limited at the Downtown Campus. The Health Sciences Campus is located near Mountaineer Field, over a ridge from the Evansdale Campus. Due to the distance between WVU's three campuses, the innovative Personal Rapid Transit (PRT) system, was built to link the campuses (Downtown, Evansdale, and Health Sciences) and to reduce student traffic on local highways. Boeing began construction on the Personal Rapid Transit (PRT) system in 1972. The unique aspect that makes the system "personal" is that a rider specifies their destination when entering the system and, depending on system load, the PRT can dispatch a car that will travel directly to that station.

Enrollment for the Fall 2016 semester was 28,488 for the main campus, while enrollment across all campuses totaled 31,287. WVU offers 191 bachelor's, master's, doctoral, and professional degree programs in 14 colleges. WVU has produced 25 Rhodes Scholars, including former WVU president David C. Hardesty, Jr. The University has also produced 44 Goldwater Scholars, 22 Truman Scholars, and five members of USA Today's "All-USA College Academic First Team."


The school's sports teams are called the Mountaineers and compete in the NCAA's Division I. The school has teams in 17 college sports and has won several national championships, including 19 NCAA Rifle Championships as of 2014. Formerly a full member of the Big East Conference in all sports, on October 28, 2011, the school accepted an invitation to join the Big 12 Conference and became a member on July 1, 2012. With a 719–477–45 record, West Virginia is the most winning Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) team to have never won a national championship.
